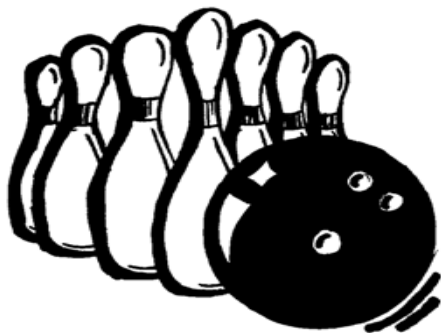

TOURNAMENT RULES

This tournament shall be open to all certified members of GCCUSBC as of October 10, 2021. This tournament shall be USBC certified and shall be operated under the rules of USBC.

1. Each Team Entry¹ shall consist of 1 Adult and 1 Junior to bowl a set of 3 games for team total (with handicap rules 3-7, below).
2. Juniors may also enter an Optional Singles Entry² side-tourney utilizing their same 3-game total (with handicap rules 3-7, below).
3. This is a handicapped tournament. Handicap is 100% of 240 for all bowlers.
4. Entering average

Adults

- A. Highest book average for 2020-2021 in a USBC Adult certified league.
- B. If no average for 2020-2021, use highest average based on 12 games or more for 2021-2022 in a USBC certified league. A standing sheet as of October 9, 2021 must be provided to the Tournament Director for those bowlers without a book average.
- C. All others must bowl with a scratch average of 240.

Juniors

- A. Highest book average for 2020-2021 in a USBC Junior certified league.
 - B. If no average for 2020-2021, use highest average based on 12 games or more for 2021-2022 in a USBC certified league. A standing sheet as of October 9, 2021 must be provided to the Tournament Director for those bowlers without a book average.
 - C. All others must bowl with a scratch average of 240.
5. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his/her partner, or others. Failure to use the proper average or make corrections prior to the completion of the series may result in disqualification (USBC Rule 319A-3). Prizes will be based on the average submitted to the tournament even if it is higher than the correct average. There will be no return of funds on disqualification.
 6. Ten pin rule does not apply.
 7. AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT/RE-RATING. Bowlers shall familiarize themselves with USBC rule 319E. Rule 319E will apply to all participants.
 8. Adult / Junior bowlers are permitted to bowl **multiple times** with different partners; Junior bowlers can only enter side-tourney **once**.
 9. Prize fund returned 100%. Prize ratio will be at least one (1) for every eight (8) entries per division.
 10. PRIZES: Scholarships will be awarded to the junior bowlers in each division at the awards luncheon.
 11. All entrants must report to the Tournament Director at least 30 minutes before scheduled event
 12. Entrants will not be allowed to leave the bowling area while bowling without permission from a Tournament Official.
 13. **Tournament Dress Code. Bowlers** must dress appropriately for a family-oriented sporting event. Bowlers cannot wear hats at any time during practice or tournament play. Also, attire cannot contain any vulgar or obscene language or images. The chart below identifies which attire is allowed or not allowed.
